


## Configuring locally administered MAC address

1. Go to Command Prompt and type the command

**C:\> ipconfig/all**

Observe the MAC address currently used by the network adapter.

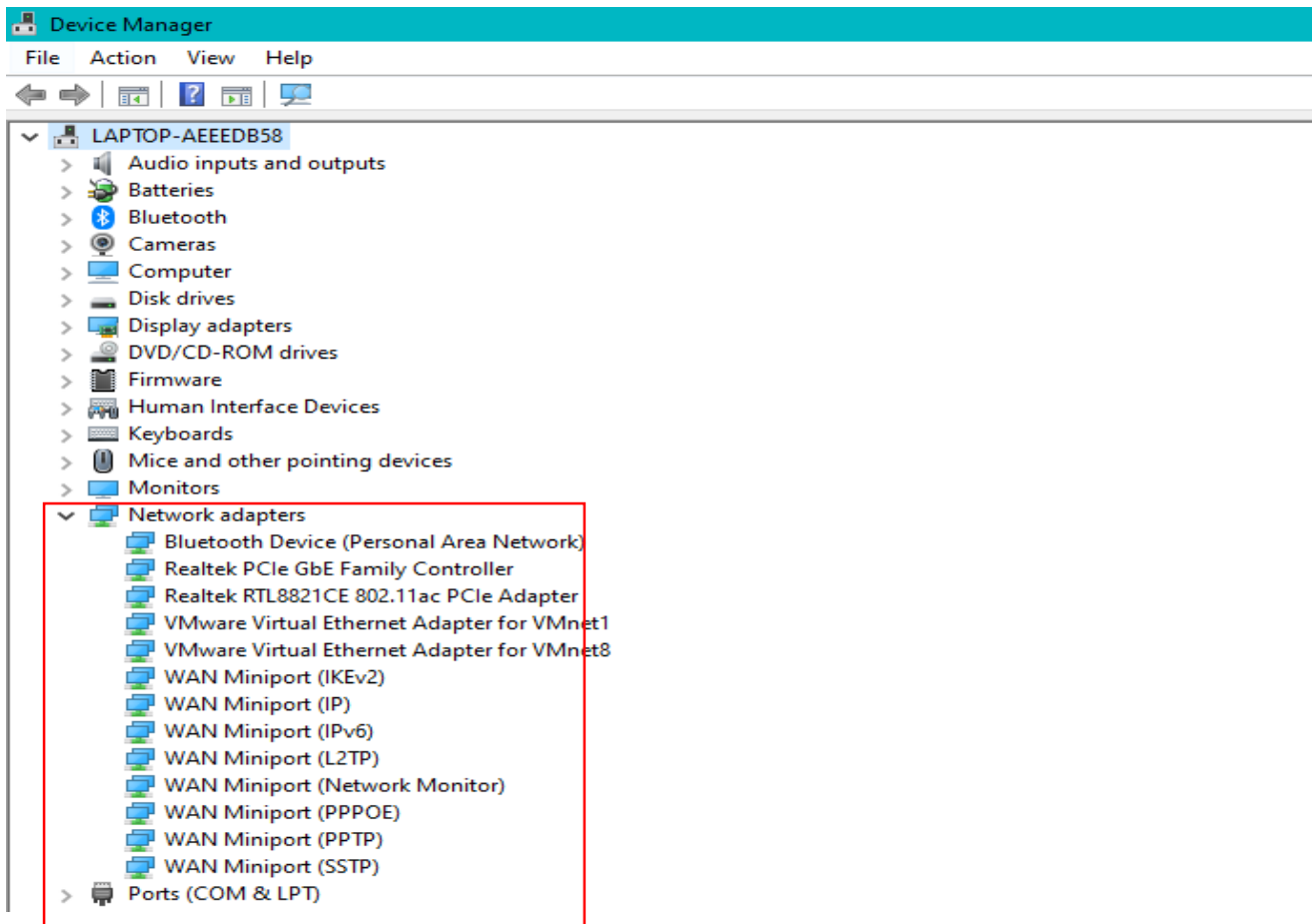

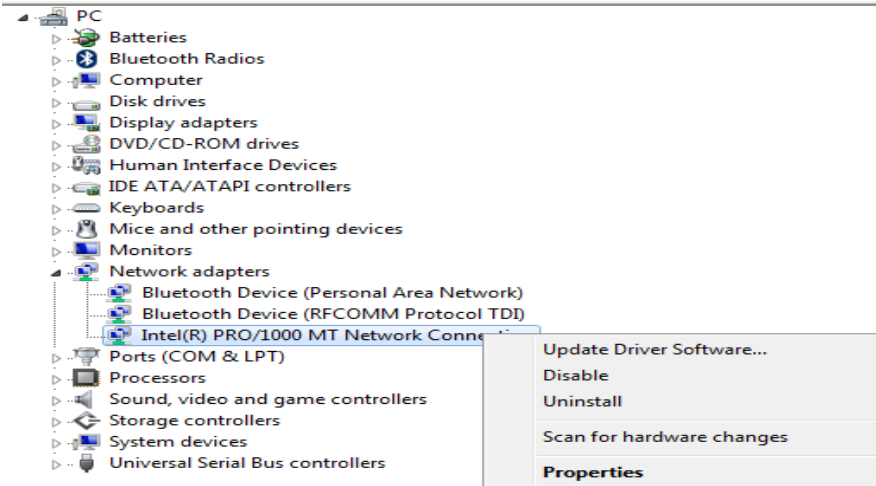

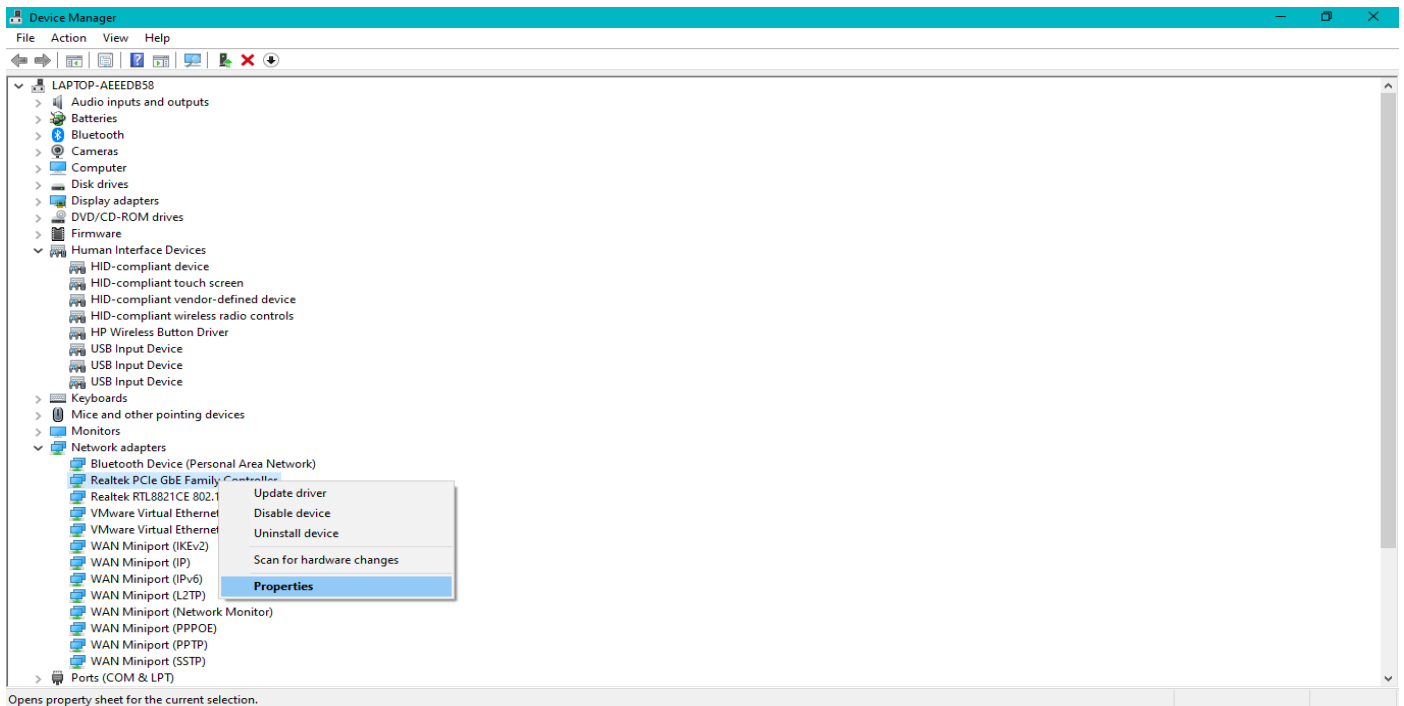
## 4. Select your Network Adapter



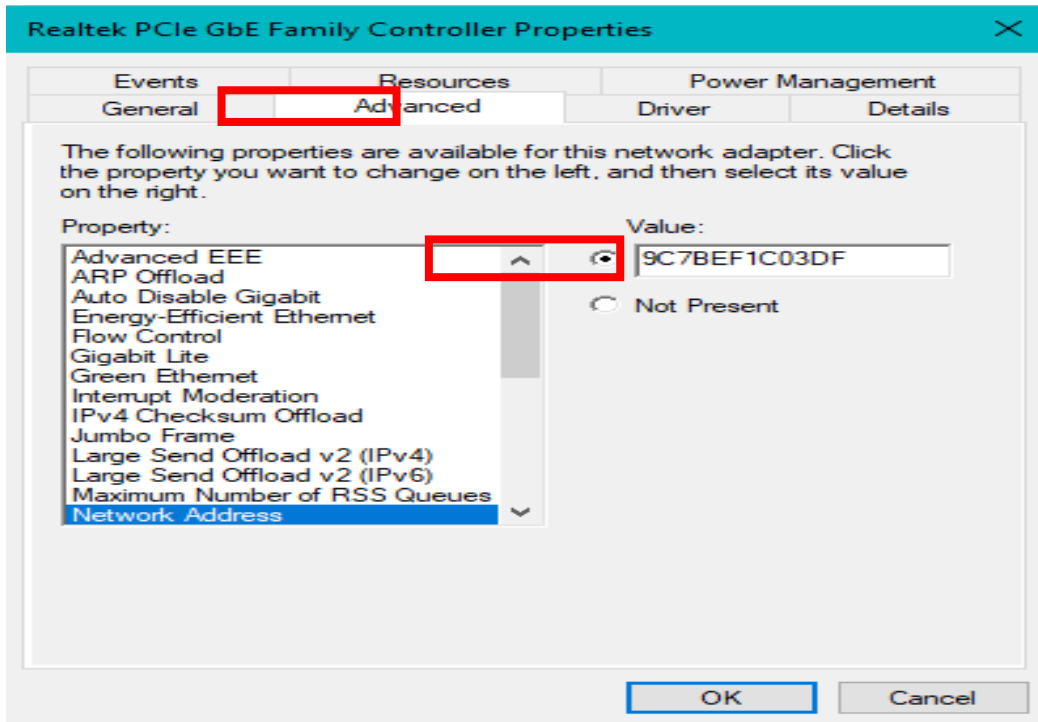
## 5. Right-Click on the desired Network Adapter and click *Properties* For Windows 7
